

James Madison FFA Booster Club
General Meeting
October 6, 2020

- The meeting was held virtually via Zoom.
- The meeting was called to order by President, Amy Biggs, at 6:33 pm.
- The minutes of the previous meeting was read by Secretary, Patty Garza.
 - The last general meeting of the Booster Club was September 8, 2020.
 - Per the financial report, balance on hand as of 9/8/2020 was \$12,076.60.
 - Under New Business, the Proposed Budget Report for 2020-2021 was approved. The Bexar County Jr Livestock Show was discussed. It was decided for us to have our own show, as well as, form an auction committee.
 - Under AMP Weekly Happenings, the following was discussed: FFA dues, NEISD partnership with Big Give SA, Meat and Fruit Fundraiser, Chapter T-shirts, Virtual Parent Night, and 7 FFA students were recognized as National Finalists in the Agriscience Fair competition and FFA Proficiency Award division.
 - Minutes were approved as read.
- Treasurer, Tracy Ballard, provided the financial report for the Booster Club.
 - Balance on hand as of 9/30/2020 was \$18,597.34.
- Committee Reports:
 - Vice President, Cori Smith, gave the Auction Committee report update. The committee met on October 1st to discuss the schedule and basic structure. The committee will meet again on October 8th to vote on a chairperson and vice chairperson. The name has been selected as the North East Ag Fair to be held on January 8th-9th, 2021. The North East Ag Fair Premium Auction will be held on January 15th-18th, 2021.
- New Business:
 - President, Amy Biggs, advised that volunteers are needed for the October 17th Fall Challenge Goat & Lamb Prospect Show and the October 24th North East Ag Fair. She also advised that donations are needed for the concession stand for both of these events. Donation drop off will be on Sunday, October 11th, from 5 pm to 7 pm.
- AMP Weekly Happenings
 - School is now in Phase 3. Students will be rotating to their different classes.
 - The end of the 9 week period is already coming up. It is important for the students to be attending their classes.
 - FFA Dues – 60% of students have paid already. Due are \$20 for the year.
 - FFA made \$1,220 from Big Give SA.
 - National FFA Convention will be held virtual the last week in October.
